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ABOUT THE TRAINING

The participating New Jersey health care associations have collaboratively designed this exercise to provide participants with an opportunity to improve upon their current emergency response capabilities and to evaluate how well emergency management issues identified during past tabletop activities have been addressed.

Tabletop Exercise: An interactive discussion-based exercise that focuses on five target capabilities including On-Site Incident Management, Emergency Planning, Emergency Public Information and Warning, Medical Surge, Mass Prophylaxis. The tabletop exercise will assist the healthcare continuum in exercising, evaluating, and validating their emergency management plans, policies and procedures.
