Home Health Aide Core Competency Exam Home Care & Hospice Module Exam

This Home Health Aide Core Competency Exam and Home Care-Hospice Module

Exam has been developed and tested for reliability by the Professional Practice Committee, Nurse Delegation Task Force of the Home Care Association Of NJ and is based upon the new Core Curriculum and Home Care-Hospice Module now in use in NJ for training of home health aides. The purpose of the test development was to provide a tool for testing students who have completed a course of study to become a Certified Home Health Aide in a NJ Board of Nursing Approved training program by a written competency process. The use of a written test is NOT required by regulations, but many agencies find that the use of a written test at the end of a training program, and in the hiring process of new aides, is often helpful but not the only criteria used for establishing competency as a home health aide. The exams were pilot tested and then reviewed for statistical significance and reliability. The questions in the attached tests have been deemed statistically significant and reliable through the use of accepted statistical processes. Purchase of the test grants the purchaser the right to reproduce and use the test within their agency.
